But this judgment except as to the cost is
to be discharged, by the payment of nine pence
fifteen shillings and eleven pence, with interest
from the 31st day of January 1771 till paid,

On the motion of Albrighton Jones guardian of
Josiah Vick, orphan of Richard Vick, alleg-
ing that the profits of the estate are not sufficient
to maintain him It is therefore ordained that the
Churchwardens of Talloway bind out the said
orphan with the consent of the said guardian to
Samuel Reddick Esq^r
