

eighteen pounds eleven shillings and ten pence the debt in the declaration mentioned, Therefore it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said eighteen pounds eleven shillings and ten pence and his cost by him about his suit in this behalf expended and the said defendant in mercy &c.

But this judgement except as to the cost is to be discharged by the payment of nine pence fifteen shillings and eleven pence with interest from the 31st day of January 1771 till paid,

An Indenture of settlements between Henry Pope & Ann his wife, of the one part and Richard Worralls of the other part and a receipt thereon endorsed were acknowledged, by the above named Henry Pope party thereto and ordered to be recorded and Ann the wife of the said Henry personally appeared in court and being first privately examined, as the law directs voluntarily relinquish'd her right of dower in the said estate conveyed by this Indenture

On the motion of Albrighton Jones guardian of Josiah Vick orphan of Richard Vick, alleging that the profits of the estate are not sufficient to maintain him It is therefore ordered that the Churchwardens of Tottenham bind out the said orphan with the consent of the said guardian to Lemuel Reddick Esq^r
