

hemen his suit in this behalf expended, and the said defendant in mercy &c. But this judgement except as to the costs is to be discharged by the payment of five pounds two shillings and nine pence, half penny together with interest from the 5th day of August 1775 till paid.

Upon the petition of John Gray V.C. against Isaac Elzey for one pound twelve shillings and six pence due by account this day came as well the plaintiff by his attorney as the defendant, on his proper person who confessed the allegations of the said petition to be true therefore it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said one pound twelve shillings and six pence and his costs by him in this behalf expended.

Ordered that Samuel Brown, Thom Mitchell, and Mattheim Wills or any two of them do settle and account current of the estate of Thomas Gresham and make report thereof to this court.

This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and the attachment awarded against the estate of the said defendant being returned, executed on of the estate of the said defendant and he not appearing to replevy the said effects on the motion of the plaintiff by his attorney it is considered by the court that he recover against the said defendant eight pounds two shillings and eight pence, and his cost by him in his suit in this behalf expended, and the said defendant in mercy &c.
