 by the Grand Jury be summoned to appear at
 the next court

The last will and testament of William Kirby
 was presented in Court by Joshua Nicholson
 one of the Executors therein named and proved by
 the oaths of David Edmunds and Robert Bittle
 two of the witnesses thereto and order'd to be
 recorded And on the motion of the said Executor
 who made oath according to Law a certificate
 was granted him for obtaining a probat there
 of in due form giving security Whereupon
 the said Joshua Nicholson with Benjamin
 Sumner and Charles Briggs his security came
 into court and acknowledge their Bond in
 the penalty of five hundred pounds for the
 due and faithful administration of the de-
 cedents estate and performance of his will

Ordered that David Edmunds Robert Bittle
 Cordell Corbett and Benjamin Bailey or any
 three of them ^(being first sworn upon oaths of the Court)
 do appraise in Current money the
 slaves if any and personal estate of William
 Kirby and return the appraisement to Court
