A Commission of the peace and Sidemus potestatum  
and a Commission of Oyer and Terminer and Sidemus  
potestatum from his Excellency the Governor under the  
Seal of this Colony bearing date the 6<sup>th</sup> November  
1772 directed to Abighton Jones and others were  
produced and read whereupon Pursuant thereto  
the said Abighton Jones had the oaths appoint-  
ed by act of parliament to be taken instead of those  
of allegiance or a supremacy the abjuration oath  
and test and took the oaths of a justice of the peace  
(a judge in chancery) administered to him by  
James Ridley and Charles Briggs which he took  
and subscribed the said last mentioned oath  
and test and took the oaths of a justice of the  
peace and judge in chancery and the oath of  
justice of Oyer and Terminer which was also ad-  
ministered him by the said James Ridley and  
Charles Briggs and then the said Abighton  
Jones administered all the above mentioned oaths  
to James Ridley Nicholas Maggs Steven Doyton  
Charles Briggs Benjamin Ruffin jun<sup>r</sup> William  
Blunt and Elias Storring which they took and  
severally subscribed the said abjuration oath &  
test.
