A Commission of the peace and Sedimus potestatum
and a Commission of Oyer and Terminer and Sedimus
potestatum from his Excellency the Governor under the
seal of this Colony bearing date the 6th of November
1772 directed to Albrighton Jones and others were
produced and read whereupon pursuant thereto
the said Albrighton Jones had the oaths appoint-
ed by act of parliament to be taken instead of the oaths
of allegiance and supremacy the abjuration oath
and test (and took the oaths of a justice of the peace
and judge in chancery) administered to him by
James Ridley and Charles Briggs which he took
and subscribed the said last mentioned oath
and test and took the oaths of a justice of the
peace and judge in chancery and the oath of
justice of Oyer and Terminer which was also ad-
ministered him by the said James Ridley and
Charles Briggs and then the said Albrighton
Jones administered at the above mentioned oaths
to James Ridley Nicholas Magle Henry Taylor
Charles Briggs Benjamin Ruffin jun^r William
Blunt and Elias Skerring which they took and
severally subscribed the said abjuration oath &
test.
