The last will and testament of William Bailey was presented in court by Barnaby Bailey one of the Executors therein named and proved by the oath of James Freeman and Charles Bailey two of the Witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded and on the motion of the said Executor who made oath according to law certificate was granted him for obtaining a probat thereof thereof in due form giving security. Whereupon the said Barnaby Bailey with

John Bailey and Richard Vickor his security entered into and acknowledged their Bond for five thousand pound for the said Barnaby's due and faithful administration of the decedent's estate and performance of his will.

Ordered that James Gray Moses Booth Jesse Canoll and William De loach or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of peace do appraise in current money the slaves of any and personal estate of William Bailey and return the appraisement to court.

The last will and testament of Simon Starnis was presented in court by Rebecca Starnis the Executrix therein named and proved by the oath of John Johnson and by the solemn affirmation of Henry Cope one of the people called quakers witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded the said Rebecca Starnis with Richard Kellor and Henry Cope entered into and acknowledged their Bond in the penalty of five hundred pound for the due and faithful administration of the decedent's estate and performance of his will.

Ordered that John Council Giles Johnson John Soyars and William Sayre or any three of them do appraise in current money the slaves of any and personal estate of Simon Starnis and return the appraisement to court.

The last of Alice Foster was presented in court by Moses Foster one of the Executors therein mentioned and
