

Ordered that James Day Ridley Brandy Lundy Boyd
Lundy and John Myrick or any three of them being first
sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current
money the slaves of any and personal estate of Mr.
Elsey and return the appraisement to court.

The last will and testament of William Bailey
was presented in court by Barnaby Bailey one of
the executors therein named and proved by the oath
of James Freeman and Charles Bailey two of the witnesses
thereto and ordered to be recorded and on the
motion of the said Executor who made oath according
to law certificate was granted him for obtaining a
probate thereof in due form giving security
Whereupon the said Barnaby Bailey with
John Bailey and Richard Miller his security
entered into and acknowledged their Bond for five
thousand pound for the said Barnabys due and
faithfull administration of the decedents estate
and performance of his will.

Ordered that James Gray Moses Booth Jeffreys Carroll
and William DeLoach or any three of them being first
sworn before a justice of peace do appraise in current
money the slaves of any and personal estate of William
Bailey and return the appraisement to court.

The last will and testament of Simon Stans was
presented in court by Rebecca Stans the executrix thereto
named and proved by the oath of John Johnson and
by the solemn affirmation of Henry Pope one of the per-
sons called quakers witness thereto and ordered to
be recorded the said Rebecca Stans with Richard
Miller and Henry Pope entered into and acknowledged
their Bond in the penalty of five hundred pound for
the due and faithfull administration of the decedents
estate and performance of his will.

Ordered that John Council Giles Johnson John Lewis
and William Lewis or any three of them do appraise
in current money the slaves of any and personal estate
of Simon Stans and return the appraisement to court.

The last will of Alice Foster was presented in court
by Moses Foster one of the executors therein mentioned
and
