Therefore it is consider'd by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said ten pounds fourteen shillings and their costs by them in their suit in this behalf expended and the said defendant in mercy &c. But this judgement except as to the cost is to be discharge'd by the payment of five pounds seven shillings and 7<sup>d</sup> together with interest from the 23 Aug. 1772 till paid.
