Upon the petition of Joseph and William Scott agst Aaron Booth for four pounds twelve shillings and four pence half penny due by account this day came the plaintiff by his attorney and the defendant being duly summoned and served with a copy of the petition and acc^{ts} and not appearing on the motion of the plaintiff by their attorney it is considered that judgement be entered for the plaintiff agst the said defendant for the said four pounds twelve shillings and four pence half and their cost by them in their suits in their behalf expended.
