Whereupon this day came the plaintiff by his attorney as also the defendant in his proper person who confessed the plaintiffs action for seven pounds seventeen shillings the debt in the declaration mentioned. Therefore it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said seven pounds seventeen shillings and his cost by him in his suit in this behalf expended and the said defendant in mercy &c.
 But this judgement except as to the costs to be discharged by the payment three pounds eighteen shillings and six pence together with interest from the 14th January 1773 till paid.

Upon the petition of John Lawrence executor of John Lawrence who was executor of Matthew Jones dec'd against Richard Marks for three pounds sixteen shillings and six pence due by bond. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and the defendant being duly summoned and served with a copy of the petition and not appearing on the motion of plaintiff by his attorney. It is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said three pounds sixteen shillings and six pence and his cost by him in his suit in this behalf expended. But this judgement except as to the costs to be discharged by the payment of one pound eighteen shillings and six pence and interest from the 23rd January 1772 till paid.
