Edwards in the Bill names viz^y Jenny for the price
of £35. - 1. Amey for £53. 3. - and Aggy for the
sum of £73. 7. 6. which in the opinion of the said
Guardian will be sufficient to pay of the plain-
tiffs their claims. Witness my hand this 5th
day of March 1773 John Crafford

Whereupon It is decreed and order'd that the
defendants guardian pay unto the plaintiffs their
respective demands when the money arising from
the sales of the negroes in the report mentioned be-
comes due, and it is further ordain'd that the cost be
equally born by the parties -
