for fifteen pounds fourteen shillings and nine pence  
together with lawfull interest from the 2 January  
1772 till paid to be computed at the rate of 5%  
per annum according to the condition of the Bond  
aforesaid and for his costs by him in this suit  
expended.

Ordered that the court be adjourned till the court  
in cause
