Upon the petition of Daniel Storring <sup>to</sup> against  
Richard Johnson for three pounds sixteen shillings  
and ten pence due by note this day came the plaintiff  
by his attorney and the defendant being duly sum-  
moned and serv'd with a copy of the petition  
and not appearing on the motion of the plaintiff  
by his attorney it is consider'd that the plain-  
tiff recover against the said defendant one pound  
eighteen shillings and five pence and his costs by  
him in his suit in this behalf expended together  
with interest from the day of 1772  
till paid.
