George Long... vs } The defendant being arrived and not appearing on the motion of the plaintiff by his attorney it is considered that judgement be entered for the plaintiff against the said def^t and Charles Long his security unless the said def^t shall appear and plead at the next court

Beverly Booth... vs } Thomas Rialley came into court and undertook for the defendant that in case the said defendant shall be cast in this suit he shall satisfy and pay all costs and damages as shall be awarded against him or that he the said Beverly will do it for him

upon the petition of Daniel Sherring^{vs} against Richard Johnson for three pounds sixteen shillings and ten pence due by note This day came the pet^r by his attorney and the defendant being duly summoned and served with a copy of the petition and not appearing on the motion of the plaintiff by his attorney It is considered that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant one pound eighteen shillings and five pence and his cost by him in his suit in this behalf expended together with interest from the day of 1772 till paid
