William Slones came into
court and undertook for the defendant that in case the
said defendant shall be cast in this suit he will
pay the condemnation of the court or render his body
to prison or he will do it for him and the said defendant
not now appearing nor offering any plea it is considered
that judgment be entered for the plaintiff against the
said defendant and the said William Slones his secu-
rity unless he shall appear & plead at the next court
