fore it is consider'd by the court that the plaintiff
take nothing by his bill but his false clamor been-
meroy &c^d and the defendant gatherfore hence
without day and recover against the said plain-
tiff his costs by him about his suit in this behalf
expended.

and William Urquhart of the other part was ack-
nowledg'd by Thomas Williamson and William
Urquhart the parties thereto and order'd to be re-
corded.

Ordered that the treasurer pay Richard Sharpe
fifteen pounds for the repairs of Black creek bridge
the same being now reported to be finished according
to agreement in the words following.

"Conformable to order of the court of South-
ampton to us directed we have view'd the repair
of Black creek bridge and find it finished to
agreement for the sum of fifteen pounds to be paid
to Rich^t Sharpe the undertaker 13th May 1773"
