William Bryant who is summoned to attend as a witness for Simon Vick against Jonas Bryant being called and not appearing Ordered that he be fined 30th Tobacco unless he make a proper excuse at the next court

Thomas Blunt gentleman took the usual oaths to his Majesty's person and government and took and subscribed the abjuration oath and subscribed the test, as also the oath of assis-
tice of Oyer and Terminer and Chancery
