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consider'd that he make his fine with our Lord  
the King by the payment of fifteen shillings to  
for the use of the government and the contingents  
charged thereof and that he pay the cost of this  
prosecution and be taken &c.

Upon the presentment of the Grand Jury ag'th  
Richard Kirby for profane swearing this day  
came the attorney for our Lord the King and the  
defendant having been duly summoned and not  
appearing nor offering any thing in excuse on the  
motion of the said attorney it is consider'd by  
the Court that he forfeit and pay unto the church  
wardens of the parish of Stottonay five shillings  
according to the act of assembly in that case made  
and provided and that he pay the cost of this  
prosecution.

The presentment of the Grand Jury against  
William Simmons for gaming is dismissed on  
hearing of the parties.

An account of the estate of Thomas  
Greswilt was this day reported by the persons  
appointed to settle the same and order'd to be  
recorded.

The presentment of the Grand Jury against  
James Taylor and Benjamin Clifton is dismissed.

Upon the presentment of the Grand Jury ag'th  
John Kirby for profane swearing this day  
came the attorney for our Lord the King and  
the defendant having been duly summoned &  
not appearing nor offering any thing in ex-  
cuse on the motion of the said attorney it is  
consider'd by the Court that he forfeit and  
pay unto the churchwardens of the parish of  
Stottonay five shillings according to  
the act of assembly in that case made &  
provided and that he pay the cost of this  
prosecution.
