 process of the law cannot be served upon him
 for a debt due from the said Mills to the said Jay
 James Jay Esq. gentleman Sheriff of this county
 who now made return that he had executed the
 attachment in the hands of Benjamin Bailey
 garnishee and summoned him as garnishee the
 day came the said Bailey who being one of the
 people called quakers solemnly affirmed that he
 hath in his hands that he hath in his hands
 fifty nine pounds six shillings and eight pence
 of the estate of the said defendant Therefore on
 the motion of the plaintiff who proved his demand
 and for one hundred and seventeen pounds ten
 shillings and ten pence it is considered by the court
 that he recover against the said Thomas the
 said one hundred and seventeen pounds ten
 shillings and ten pence and his cost by him
 in this behalf expended But this judgement
 except as to the cost is to be discharged by the
 payment of fifty eight pounds fifteen shillings
 and ten pence and interest from the 5th
 September 1778 till paid two hundred and
 twenty nine pounds of gross tobacco and six
 teen shillings and three pence also three pence
 twelve shillings and ten pence Sheriffs com-
 missions And it is ordered that the said
 garnishee pay the Balance in his hands to-
 wards satisfying the judgement & cost
