for Thirteen pounds three shillings the debt in
the declaration mention'd therefore it is consid-
er'd by the court that the said plaintiff recover
against the said defendant the said Thirteen
pounds three shillings and his cost by him about
his suit in this behalf expended and the said
defendant in mercy V^c. But this judgement as
except as to the cost is to be discharge'd by the
payment of Three pound nine shillings and
eight pence half penny together with interest
from the 5th March 1773 till paid.
