

On the motion of the plaintiff by his attorney and by virtue of the act of Assembly in that case made and provided the said defendant having had legal notice hereof execution is awarded the plaintiff against the said defendant for seven pounds nine shillings and sixpence together with interest from the 20th March 1778 till paid according to the condition of the Bond aforesaid and for his costs by him in this behalf expended.

On the motion of Thomas Ridley a witness for Joseph Mountfort against Jonathan Bowring for Daniel Storing against Henry Pope for Daniel Storing &c. against John Cherry for William Urquhart Absinger of George Sumnerdell against Joseph Bradshaw for Richard Wmwell against Thomas Hart and Jethro Denson and Daniel Storing against Mr. Mackie Ordain that they severally pay him twenty five pounds of Tobacco for one days attendance on this court for each according to law.

On the motion of William Shines a witness for William Salter against Randall Davis Thomas Davis and Anthony Evans Ordain that the said Salter pay him twenty five pounds of Tobacco for one days attendance on this court according to law.

On the motion of Samuel Slade a witness for Jordan Denson auditor of Joseph Denson against Benjamin Denson Ordain that the said Jordan pay him two hundred and twenty five pounds of Tobacco for nine days attendance on this court according to law.

Charles Briggs Benjamin Ruffin and Edwin Gray are ordered by the court to be recommended to his excellency the Governor as fit & able persons to serve as sheriff the ensuing year.
