

On the motion of the plaintiff by his attorney and by virtue of the act of Assembly in that case made and provided the said defendant having had legal notice hereof execution is awarded to the plaintiff against the said defendant for Seven pounds nine shillings and six pence together with interest from the 20th March, 1778 till paid according to the condition of the Bond aforesaid and for his costs by him in this cause half suspended.

On the motion of Thomas Ridley a witness for Joseph Mountfort against Jonathan Bowring for Daniel Stirling against Henry Pope for Daniel Stirling & Co against John Oberry for William Urquhart & signs of George Summerell against Joseph Bradshaw for Richard Worrall against Thomas Hart and Sethia Denson and Daniel Stirling against William Mackie Ordred that they severally pay him twenty five pounds of Tobacco for one days attendance on this court for each according to law.

On the motion of William Stein a witness for William Salter against Randall Davis Isham Davis and Anthony Evans, Ordred that the said Salter pay him twenty five pounds of Tobacco for one days attendance on this court according to law.

On the motion of Samuel Slade a witness for Jordan Denson admittor of Joseph Denson agt. Benjamin Denson ordred that the said Jordan pay him two hundred and twenty five pounds of Tobacco for nine days attendance on this court according to law.

Charles Briggs Benjamin Ruffin and Edwin Gray are ordred by the court to be recommended to his excellency the Governor as fit & able persons to serve as Sheriff the ensuing year.
