Benjamin Clifton appears to answer the complaint of John Kirby who demands a surety of the peace of the said Ben^g having taken the usual oath in that case made and provided therefore it is order'd that the said Ben Clifton find surety for his good behaviour the space of 12 Calendar months viz^t the the said Benjamin in the sum of Fifty pounds and the security in the sum of Twenty five pounds and it is further order'd that the said Benjamin be committed to the goal of this county untill he find such security
