was presented in court by Benjamin Turner one of
the executors therein named and proved by the oaths
of John Allen and Mattheus Brett two of the
Witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded and
on the motion of the said Executor whomade
oath according to law certificate is granted him
for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving
Security. Whereupon the said Benjamin Turner
Richard Manning and Edmund Tyler enter into
and acknowledge their Bond in the penalty of
Twenty shillings and pounds for the due and faithful
administration of the decedents estate and perfor-
mance of his will.

Brett and Edmund Brett or any three of them being
first sworn before a justice of peace as officers con-
current money the slaves (if any) and personal estate
of Joseph Turner deced and make report thereof
to this court.

and Ann his wife of the one part and Joseph Hall
of the other parts and the memorandum of giving &
receiving thereon inclosed were acknowledged by the said
Jethro Denson and Ann his wife she being first pri-
vately examined as the law directs and ordered to
be recorded.
