inclosed were acknowledged by the within named  
Francis Storvel and Mary his wife she being  
first privately examined as the law directs and or-  
dered to be recorded.

An Indenture of feoffment between Richard Kirby  
of the one part and Benjamin Kirby of the other part,  
was acknowledged by the said Richard Kirby and  
ordered to be recorded.

The last will and testament of Joseph Turner  
was presented on court by Benjamin Turner one of  
the executors therein named and proved by the oaths  
of Abner Allen and Matthew Brill two of the  
Witnesses thereto and orac'd to be recorded and  
on the motion of the said executor whom made  
oath according to law certificate is granted him  
for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving  
Security. Whereupon the said Benjamin Turner  
Richard Manning and Edmund Tyler entered into  
and acknowledged their Bond in the penalty of  
Twenty shillings and pounds for the due and faithful  
administration of the decedents estate and perfor-  
mance of his will.

Ordered that John Clayton Jesse Boone Benjamin  
Brill and Edmund Brill or any three of them being  
first sworn before a justice of peace as officers con-  
current money the slaves (if any) and personal estate  
of Joseph Turner deed and make report thereof  
to this court.

An Indenture of feoffment between Jethro Denson  
and Ann his wife of the one part and Joseph Hall  
of the other part, and the memorandum of giving &  
receiving thereon inclosed were acknowledged by the said  
Jethro Denson and Ann his wife she being first pri-  
vately examined as the law directs and ordered to  
be recorded.
