Blake This day came as well the plaintiff by his attorney as the defendant Samuel in his proper person who confessed the plaintiff's action for eleven pounds fifteen shillings and ten pence the debt in the declaration mentioned. Therefore it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant Samuel the said eleven pounds fifteen shillings and ten pence, and his costs by him about his suit in this behalf expended and the said defendant in money &c. But this judgement except as to the costs to be discharged by the payment of five pounds twelve shillings and four pence three farthings together with interest from the 23 July 1773 till paid, and the defendant Thomas being called and not appearing on the motion of the said plaintiff an attachment is awarded against the estate of the said def^t for eleven pounds fifteen shillings and ten pence and costs returnable to the next court.

An Indenture of peppment between John Lloyd of the one part and Benjamin Cumber of the other part and the receipt thereon endorsed was proved by the oaths of Elias Herring and Beasant Cumber two of the witnesses thereto and on the 10th March 1774 this Indenture was further proved by the oath of John Brett another witness & ordered to be recorded.
