This day came as well the plaintiff by his attorney as the defendant in his proper person who confessed the plaintiffs action for four pounds the debt in the declaration mentioned. Therefore it is considered by the court that the p^{ty} recover against the said defendant the said four pounds and his cost by him about his suit on this behalf expended and the said defendant in mercy &c. But this judgement except as to the cost is to be discharged by the payment of three pounds together with interest from the 13th June 1767 till p^{ay}.

Upon the petition of Richard Kello against James Williamson adm^{or} of Benjamin Williamson d^{ft} for one pound nineteen shillings and one penny due by account. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and the defendant being duly summoned and served with a copy of the petition and answer and not appearing on the motion of the said plaintiff who proved his demand to be just. It is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said one pound nineteen shillings & one penny and his cost by him about his suit on this behalf expended.

On the motion of Benjamin Griffin a witness for Richard Kello agst James Williamson adm^{or} of Benjamin Williamson. Ordered that the said Kello pay him twenty five pounds of tobacco for one day attendance on this court according to law.

Upon the petition of Thomas Lambford a jun^r agst Joseph Powell for four pounds twelve shillings and six pence due by note. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and the defendant being duly summoned and served with a copy of the petition and not appearing on the motion of the plaintiff by his attorney. It is considered that the plaintiff recover agst the said defendant the said four pounds
