him to keep an ordinary at his house in this County
Whereupon the said Mountfort with Lawrence
Joyner is security entered into and acknowledged
his Bond in the penalty of fifty pounds for keeping
the said ordinary according to law and it is order'd
that the Clerk of this court prepare a license for him
accordingly
