Mountfort and Elisha Fly and that he had summoned the said Jas. Mountfort and that he had summoned him as garnishee who being sworn depos'd that he hath in his hands belonging to the estate of the said defendant three pounds subject to a constable attachment of Recd. Recas fee 16/3. £ 2/6 costs also the Sheriff's fees recd for Arys 9/6 £ 1/15 considered by the court that they . . . . . recover agst the said defendant and eight hundred and forty six pounds of Tobacco and fifteen shillings, Orderd that the garnishee pay the balance in his hands towards satisfying the said judgement and that an attachment be issued agst the other garnishee.
