interest on the same from the 25th Dec^r. 1772 till
this day and their cost by them about their suit
in this behalf expended.

On the motion of John Lightfoot a witness for
Joseph & Arthur Williamson Executors of the last will &
testament of Elizur Williamson dec'd at the suit
of Simon Durmer Executor of the last will and testa-
ment of Elizur Williamson ordered that the said
Joseph & Arthur pay him six hundred and fifty two
pounds of Tobacco for eight days attendance on
this court and travelling Twenty four miles ~~per~~
Times according to law.

On the motion of Thomas Stevens a witness for
Simon Durmer Executor of the last will and testaments of
Elizur Williamson dec'd vs Joseph & Arthur Williamson
Executors of the last will and Testaments of Elizur
Williamson dec'd Ordered that the said Simon pay
him one hundred and seventy pounds of Tobacco
for seven days attendance on this court according to
law.
