Therefore it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendants Eleven pounds three shillings the debt in the declaration mentioned together with interest on the same from the 25th Dec^r 1772 till this day and their cost by them about their suit in this behalf expended.

On the motion of John Lightface a witness for Jesse Parther Williamson, Executors of the last will & testament of Arthur Williamson, dec'd at the suit of Simon Turner, Executor of the last will and testament of Aaron Williamson, order that the said Jesse Parther pay him six hundred and fifty two pounds of Tobacco for eight days attendance on the court and travelling twenty four miles six times according to law.

On the motion of Thomas Stevens a witness for Simon Turner Executor of the last will and testament of Aaron Williamson, dec'd vs Jesse Parther Williamson, Executors of the last will and testament of Arthur Williamson, dec'd. Order that the said Simon pay him one hundred and seventy pounds of Tobacco for seven days attendance on this court according to law.
