An Inventory and appraisement of the estate of John Cooper was this day returned and ordered to be recorded.

Whereupon the said Claud with James Jones and Samuel Blake his securitys came into Court and acknowledged their Bond in the penalty of one thousand pounds for securing the said orphans estate and administering the same.
