An Indenture of feoffment between William Nick of the one part and James Williamson of the other parts was acknowledged by the said William Nick and ordered to be recorded

Articles of agreement between John Rogers and Hinchell Gilliam was proved by the oaths of Thomas Lundy the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded

An Indenture of feoffment between Benjamin Sperry and Lucy his wife of the one part and Elijah Vason of the other part was acknowledged by the said Benjamin Sperry and Lucy his wife she being first privately examined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded

An Indenture of feoffment between Thomas Dretlow and Mary his wife of the one part and Ethelred Canaster of the other parts and the memorandum of livery and seign thereon ended is acknowledged by the Dretlow and ordered to be recorded
