Ordered that John Thomas Blom John Underwood John Johnson sen^r and John Johnson jun^r or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves of any and personal estate of Sarah Williams and return the appraisement to the next court

An Indenture of feoffment between William Rich of the one part and James Williamson of the other part was acknowledged by the said William Rich and order to be recorded

Articles of agreement between John Rogus and Hincha Gilliam was proved by the oaths of John Lundy the witnesses thereto and order to be recorded

An Indenture of feoffment between Benjamin Spiry and Lucy his wife of the one part and Elijah Vasser of the other part was acknowledged by the said Benjamin Spiry and Lucy his wife she being first privately examined as the law directs and order to be recorded

An Indenture of feoffment between Thomas Drestlow and Mary his wife of the one part and Elizabeth Lane castor of the other part and the memorandum of being and seign thereon made was acknowledged by the Drestlow and order to be recorded
