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Whereupon the said William Verghart with Richard Nelson his security entered into and acknowledged their Bonds in the penalty of five hundred pounds for the due and faithful administration of the decedent's estate.

An Indenture of feoffment between David Dawson and Ann his wife of the one part and John Wilkinson of the other was acknowledged by the within named David Dawson & Ann his wife she being first privately examined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that Lewis Joyner Isaac Williams John Davis and Nicholas Williams or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Thomas Wiles and return the appraisement to this court.

The last will and Testament of Eleanor Calthorpe was this day presented in court and proved by the solemn affirmation of Joshua Bailey one of the people called quakers a witness thereon and ordered to be recorded and on the motion of James Butts Calthorpe the summing executor refusing the probate administration with the will annexed is granted him on giving security Whereupon the said James Butts Calthorpe with Anthony Calthorpe his security entered into and acknowledged their Bond in the penalty of five hundred pounds for the due and faithful administration on the decedent's estate and performance of his will.

Ordered that James Gray Barnaby Bailey Jesse Camble and Henry Cocker or any three of them of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Eleanor Calthorpe and return the appraisement to this court.

An Indenture of feoffment between William Biddle & Elizabeth his wife of the one part and Henry Biddle of the other part and the Memorandum of Henry C. Seizen thereon entered were proved by the oaths of William Miller Shadrach Kennechough and Samuel Hendred three of the witnesses thereon and ordered to be recorded.
