Ordered that Lewis Syuer Isaac Williams John Davis
and Nicholas Williams or any three of them being
first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise
in current money the slaves if any and personal estate
of Thomas Wills and return the appraisement
to this court

The last will and testament of Eleanor Calthope
was this day presented in court and proved by the
solemn affirmation of Joshua Bailey one of the people
called quakers a witness thereto and order'd to be
recorded and on the motion of James Butts Calthope
the summing executor refusing the probate adminis
tration with the will annex'd is granted him on
giving security Whereupon the said James Butts
Calthope with Anthony Calthope his security ent
ered into and acknowledged their Bond in the pe
nalty of five hundred pounds for the due and faith
full administration on the decedent's estate and per
formance of his will

Ordered that James Gray Barnaby Bailey Joyce Cane
and Henry Cocher or any three of them being
first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in
current money the slaves of any and personal estate
of Eleanor Calthope and return the appraisement
to this court

An Indenture of feoffment between William Biddle
& Elizabeth his wife of the one part and Henry Biddle
of the other part and the Memorandum of several
seizes thereon endos'd were proved by the oaths
of William Miller Shadrach Hemmrough and
Samuel Kindred three of the witnesses thereto
and order'd to be recorded
