

On the motion of Anthony Calthorpe who made oath according to law certificate was granted him for attaining letters of administration on the estate of Edward Calthorpe Whereupon the said Anthony with Edm^r Taylor and James Butts Calthorpe his Securities entered into and acknowledged their bond ^{in the penalty of one thousand pounds} for the due and faithful administration on the decedents estate

Ordered that Moses Booth Thomas Onoy Nathaniel Cooper and John Windham or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Anthony Calthorpe and return the appraisement to this court

A Bond from Edmund Day to John Day was acknowledged by Edmund Day and ordered to be recorded

A Bill of Sale from John Day to Edmund Day was acknowledged by John Day and ordered to be recorded

An Inventory and appraisement of the estate of Simon Turner was this day returned and ordered to be recorded

Ordered that William Blunt, John Blunt and John Sturgeon or any two of them do examine state and settle an account of the estate of Mary Whites and make report thereof to this court

A Report concerning Taylors bridge was this day returned in the words following "In Obedience to an order of the court of Southampton bearing date July Court 1774 We the subscribers have left the rebuilding of Taylors bridge cross the borrowing over to M^r John Dawson for the sum of 2000 pounds current money of Virginia to be completed by the last day of November next ensuing agreeable to a plan and Bond taken and to be returned to Brunswick court

We the subscribers have view'd the aforesaid Bridge and find it completed in a workmanlike manner quite agreeable to the plan of building
