ment to this court.

process of the law cannot be served upon him for a debt
due from the said Seths to the said Williamson
Charles Briggs Gentleman Sheriff of this county non-
made return that he had executed the said attach-
ment in the hands of William Seths and that he had
summoned him as garnishee.

At Dead Pole — — — from John Loyal to Molly

proved by the oaths of Pleasant Cumpfer John Britt
Henry Love three of the witnesses thereto and ordered
to be recorded.

An Indenture of feoffment between William Vaughan
of the one part and Corral & reflect of the other party
with the memorandum of twenty & six days was proved
by the oaths of Nath'l Turner Henry Turner and Ben-
jamin Turner witnesses thereto and ordered to be re-
corded.

Ordered that the treasurer pay Peterson Shope three
pounds nineteen shillings for the rebuilding Buckhan-
bridge and account with the court for the same.

Ordered that the treasurer pay Nathan Bryant three
pounds four shillings and six pence for the repair of
Flat Swamp bridge and putting up four signs
posts and account with the court for the same.

Peterson Shope having obtained an attachment against
the estate of Thomas Andrews who hath privately re-
moved himself, or so absconds that the ordinary pro-
cess of the law cannot be served upon him for a debt due
from the said Andrews to the said Shope Charles
Briggs Gentleman Sheriff of this county non made re-
turn that he had executed the said attachment on all
the estate of the said Thomas Andrews in the hands
of John Westhake and George Andrews and that he
had
