Present Nicholas Lloyd Agent about Ben^y Ruffin Benjamin Ruffin Gentleman took the usual oaths to his Majesty's person and government and took and subscribed the abjuration oath as a vestryman of the parish of St. Mary which is ordered to be certified

It appearing to the Court that Priscilla Garner having been formerly bound to serve until she arrive to the age of 31 Years to one John Bradby agreeable to an act of Assembly then in force and the said Bradby being not able to perform the covenants of the said Indenture on the motion of John Scott who is willing to perform the said Indenture that the said Priscilla be assigned over to the said John Scott for the remainder of the said term and agreeable to the term of the said Indenture
