May 1778 and hereunto annexed We the subscribers have sold the negro woman and her increase in the bill of sale to Miles Lawrence for the sum of Eighty pounds for which we have taken his Bond with Richard Boaz Sherrin of the county of the Isle of Wight his security pay able in twelve months and we allotted of eight & set apart the dower of the defendant Rebecca in the lands of Simon Harris deceased her former husband as follows

Beginning at the mouth of Stony branch which divides this land from the lands of Hardy Pope thence up Grandy run Branch to a marked gum thence by a line of marked trees through the plantation Orchard to a marked small black gum in a prong of Stony run down that to a Stony run Branch and down that to the beginning for our own hands this 8th day of Aug^r 1778
