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Whereupon it is decreed and ordaind that the defendants retain the sum of five pounds three shillings and one penny the defendants proportion of the child's part in the bill that the sum of Seventy seven pounds six shillings and six pence the balance of the sale of the negro be equally divided between the complainant's and that the doer be confirmed as laid off by the report. The costs of this suit to be equally born by both parties

An Indenture of feoffment between James Moore and Elizabeth his wife of the one part and James Bradley of the other part and the memorandum of livery and seizen thereon indorsed were acknowledg'd by the said James Moore and Elizabeth his wife parties thereto she being first privately examin'd as the law directs and ordaind to be recorded

Mary his wife

An Indenture of feoffment between J^r Bradley of the one part and James Moore of the other part and the memorandum of livery and seizen were acknowledg'd by the said John Bradley and Mary his wife parties thereto she being first privately examin'd as the law directs and ordaind to be recorded

On the motion of William Pope who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining Letters of administration on the estate of Joseph Pope Whereas the said William Pope with John Thomas Blom his security entered into and acknowledg'd his Bond for the penalty of two hundred pounds for the due and faithful administration on the decedents estate

Ordaind that Thomas Edwards Edmund Day Richard Blom and Israel Saxner or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in convenient money the slaves of any and personal estate of Joseph Pope and return the appraisement to their court

XX Joseph and William Scott having obtained an attachment against the estate of Josiah Johnson who hath privately removed himself or so absconded that the ordinary process of the law cannot be served upon him for a debt due from the said Johnson to the said Scotts
