Report concerning a road from George Joy's to Taylor's road near John Munday was this day returned in the words following. In Obedience to an order of Court of Southampton County with the subscribers being first sworn to view the convenience and inconveniency of a road from Sticks food road near George Joy's to Taylor's road near the Mundays and we do find the most convenient way as follows Beginning on Sticks food road at the below Adams rail path leaving Samuel Stanison to the right and crossing the flat swamp below George Joy's leading William Stanison on the right to Bradley's Old Mill Path down the said path as it now goes across the hill back through Colin Parsons cornfield (by his consent) to James Womack's line running near the said line to St. Mary's Church by the said Church as the old path leads into Taylor's road near John Munday

Ordered that the Church warden of Bottony bind out Lucy Browning a poor child according to Law
