A report concerning a road from George Sny's to Taylors road near John Mundalls was this day returned in the words following "In Obedience to an order of Court of Southampton County in the subscribers being first sworn to view the convenience and inconvenience of a road from Stichs ford road near George Sny's to Taylors road near the Mundalls and we do find the most convenient way as follows Beginning on Stichs ford road at little below Adams rail path leaving Samuel Stanison to the right and crossing the flat swamp below George Sny's leaving William Andrews on the right to Bradleys Old Mill Path down the said path as it now goes across the old tail through Colin Parsons corn field (by his consent) to James Wommachs line running near the said line to St. Marys Church by the said Church as the old path leads into Taylors road near John Mundalls
