

process of the law cannot be denied upon him for a debt due from the said Clifton to the said Drew as Executor to the said Claud Benjamin Ruffin jun^r gentleman Sheriff of this County now made that he had executed the said attachment on a parcel of Corn &c. in the hands of Nath^l Ridley who by affidavit before a magistrate deposed that he hath paid pounds sixteen shilling 8 and three pence of the estate of the defendants in his hands and the said defendant not now appearing to reply the said effect Therefore on the motion of the plaintiff by his Attorney It is considered by the Court that the Plaintiff recover against the said defendant Five pounds Eighteen shilling 8 and ten pence to be discharged by the payment of Three pounds Three shilling 8 and eleven pence with interest on Two pounds nineteen shilling 8 and five pence from the 27th October 1774 till paid together with costs Orderd that the Garnishee pay the Balance in his hands towards satisfaction of this judgement and that the Sheriff sell the Corn by him attached to discharge the residue or so much thereof as the sale shall amount to and make report of his proceedings to this Court

An Indenture of feoffment between Peter Hines of the one part and Jordan Denson of the other part with the rec^d thereon endor^d were acknowledged by the said Peter Hines and orderd to be recorded

Orderd that the Treasurer of this County pay Nath^l Boyant One pound ten shillings for the repairs of Flat swamp bridge near Nathan Hines and Three pounds four shilling 8 and six pence for repairing the Flat swamp bridge near John Wilkinsons and acco^{ts} wth the Court for the same

Orderd that the Treasurer of this County pay Tho^s Selwyn One pound seven shillings and six pence for putting up Angelica bridge and acco^{ts} wth the Court for the same

Orderd that the Court be adjourned till the Court in course
