An Indenture of feoffment Between Joel Davis and Ann
his wife of the one part and John Morris of the other
part was acknowledg'd by the said Joel Davis and Ann
his wife she being first privately examined as the law directs
and order'd to be record'd

An Indenture of feoffment Between Henry Morgan of the
one part and John McElmore of the other part on the 12.
of August 1773 was prov'd by the oaths of John Catshope
and Delse Spanis two of the witnesses thereto and on the
9th May 1773 was further prov'd by the oath of Will^m
Morgan one other of the witnesses thereto and order'd to
be record'd

upon the petition of Colen Parsons setting forth, That whereas
he is proprietor of the land adjoining Burns Branch where
an old Mill formerly stood praying for an order to Build
a Mill at the same place which will be very serviceable to
the inhabitants And for an order of land on the South
side belonging to Benj^m Clifton Order'd that the Sheriff
summon a Jury of twelve freeholders of the vicinage to meet
upon the said land and that they being first sworn before
a magistrate or the said Sheriff do diligently view and
examine the land petition'd for and the lands adiacent
to either in this or the next County on both sides the river
