An Indenture of feoffment Between Joel Davis and Ann his wife of the one part and John Morris of the other part was acknowledged by the said Joel Davis and Ann his wife she being first privately examin'd as the law directs and order'd to be recorded

An Indenture of feoffment Between Henry Mooney of the one part and John M^cLeomore of the other part on the 12th of August 1779 was proved by the oaths of John Calhoun and Jesse Harris two of the witnesses thereto and on the 9th May 1778 was further proved by the oath of Will^m Morgan one other of the witnesses thereto and order'd to be recorded

Upon the petition of Colin Parsons setting forth that whereas he is proprietor of the land adjoining James Branch where an old Mill formerly stood praying for an order to Build a Mill at the same place which will be very serviceable to the inhabitants And for an order of land on the South side belonging to Benjⁿ Clifton Order'd that the Sheriff summon a Jury of Twelve freeholders of the Vicinage to meet upon the said land and that they being first sworn before a Magistrate or the said Sheriff do diligently view and examine the land petition'd for and the lands adjacent thereto either in this or the next County on both sides the run
