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of the said swamp that may be affected or laid under water by building such Mill together with the timber and other conveniences thereon that they report the same with the true value of the said petitioners for and the damages to the party holding the same or to any other person or persons to the next Court under their hands and Seals.

Ordered that the Treasurer of this County pay to Bailey Branch Three pounds for the repairs of Sea Cuck Bridge & accot with the Court for the same

Ordered that the Churchwardens of the parish of St Luke with Joshua Nicholson bind Henry Thorpe orphan of Aaron Thorpe to Benj^d Butts according to law

The last will and Testament of Samuel Harrison was this day presented in Court by Joshua Nicholson one of the Executors therein named liberty being reserved for the other Executor Edward Lindy to qualify and proved by the oaths of James Lindy Jun^r and William Morgan two of the Witnesses thereto and Ordered to be recorded And on the motion of the said Executor who made oath according to law, a certificate was granted them for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security Whereupon the said Joshua Nicholson with Arthur Foster his security entered into and acknowledged their Bonds in the penalty of Five hundred pounds for the due and faithful Administration on the decedents estate and performance of his will

Ordered that James Lindy John Rogers William Andrews and George Iny or any three of them being first sworn before a Justice of the peace do appraise in Curr^t money the slaves of any and personal estate of Samuel Harrison and return the appraisement to this Court

A Report concerning Docters Bridge was this day returned in the words following In Obedience to the order of the County Court of Southampton and Isle of Wight We the Subscribers thereby appointed have viewed the bridge lately erected by Joseph Lancaster and Mills Williford at Docters Ferry over Blackwater in the said County and do report that the said Bridge was undertaken for the sum of Seventy eight pounds and that the same is completed according to the Agreement entered into with us given under our hands this fourth day of May 1776
