The last will of Lucy Taylor was presented in court by Henry Taylor one of the executors therin named and proved by the oath of Henry Taylor one of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded And on the motion of the said executors who made oath according to law certificate is granted them for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security Whereupon the said Executor with John Taylor his security entered into back bond to their bond in the penalty of two thousand pounds for the said executors due and faithful administration on the said decedents estate and performance of her will

Ordered that Benjamin Lewis John Simmons Arthur Foster and Alexander Murray or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves of any personal estate of Lucy Taylor deceased return the appraisement to the next court

Prs. Henry Taylor Govt

The last will and testament of Edmund Gay deceased was presented in court by William Scott the last written name proved by the oath of Richard Johnson a witness thereto and having been before proved by another witness is ordered to be recorded for the motion of the said executor the affirm'd according to law (being one of the people called quakers) certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security Whereupon the said executors with Thomas Edmund his security entered into acknowledgement their bond in the penalty of one thousand pounds for the said executors due & faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent and performance of his will

Ordered that John Taylor William Miller Arthur Foster & John F. Brown or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves of any personal estate of Edmund Gay deceased return the appraisement to the next court
