Ordned that Benjamin Lewis John Simmons Arthur Foster and Absalom Henry or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves if any & personal estate of Lucy Taylor decd & return the appraisement to the next court

Whereupon the said exec with Thomas Edmunds his security entered into Acknowledged their bond in the penalty of one thousand pounds for the said Exors due & faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent and performance of his will
